It's with great pride and gratitude that I present the results of our "Recovery Bowl" fundraiser—an event powered by the heart of our fellowship and our shared commitment to recovery. Financial Breakdown

We kept expenses at \$1,808, covering shirts and food to set the stage for a memorable day. Our community's generosity did the rest. Here's where the magic happened:

- Registrations: 66 members and friends signed up, raising \$1,250.
- Squares: The squares game brought in \$540, a fun way to pitch in.
- Shirt Sales: On-site sales soared to \$1,685.

The Bottom Line

- Total Revenue: $\$1,250 + \$540 + \$1,685 + \$575 = \$4,050$
- Total Expenses: \$1,808
- Net Proceeds: $\$4,050 - \$1,808 = \$2,242$

That's \$2,242 headed straight to our NA convention fund—money to make it a powerful, life-changing experience for all who attend.

PUBLIC RELATIONS

Greetings from the Public Relations Subcommittee. The Public Relations Subcommittee has continued to meet on the second Sunday of each month. PR set up a table at the Winter Recovery Ball, hosted by Beautiful Beginnings, which took place on Friday, February 7, 2025. The cost to set up a table as a vendor was \$50.00. The PR Subcommittee also set up a table at the 2025 SOMA Mardi Gras Parade on Saturday, March 1, 2025. The cost for non-profits was \$0, so PR did not have to pay to set up at the SOMA event. On March 1, 2025, PR purchased literature in the amount of \$81.00. The PR Subcommittee Chair is still working with Lamar Advertising on a public service announcement digital billboard spot for NA. Lamar advised that it could not accept money, even a nominal amount, for the billboard. The NA Public Relations Handbook explains:

We may fear that when we aren't charged for a thirty-second spot on a radio program or for an informational NA poster in a train station, we are not being self-supporting. Public service announcements are often available to charitable organizations. In these situations, the media is providing the public with a service through these announcements. Public service announcements do not compromise or jeopardize our principle of self-support. These are opportunities that the public creates for community service organizations.

In light of the PR Handbook's guidance, it seems clear that Lamar's running of a public service announcement for NA would not violate our traditions.

Turning to upcoming events, the PR Subcommittee will hold a PR Workshop on Saturday, April 19, 2025 at 1:15 pm.

The PR Subcommittee bank account balance is \$184.00 and we are holding \$333.55 cash. PR has returned the two (2) checks previously issued to it by Area to the Area Treasurer. The checks were written for \$178 apiece, or \$356 total. The total funds held by the PR Subcommittee from all sources at this time is \$517.55.

OLD BUSINESS

M1-011925. Passed. The Convention Committee would like to submit a motion for Area to procure a wireless PA and microphones.
