CAACNA XXXVII was an incredible success! Held August 8–10 at the Hilton Garden Inn in Little Rock, we welcomed 247 registered members representing a total of 1,625 years of clean time. The weekend was filled with powerful speakers, heartfelt workshops, and fellowship that truly brought our theme "I Can't, We Can" to life. Every workshop was recorded and is now available on Star Recording's website for anyone who wants to relive the experience. Financially, the convention brought in \$13,493 through registration (\$6,917.83), silent auction (\$3,590), convention shirts (\$1,724.81), raffle tickets (\$732.76), and donations (\$527.60).
